Boom in the CO₂ Market in the USA due to CO₂ Market Shortage

According to a recent article published by Gas World – July 4, it appears that the CO₂ market is witnessing shortages in several areas of the United States. The shortage is stemming from apparent quality issues in raw gas, which means that CO₂ capture firms operating in these markets cannot operate at full capacity.
